Remove Structural Barriers to Success

Strengthening Developmental Reform Education Implementation
The Education Trust, Inc. | \$450,000 | 01/2024 - 12/2025

This grant supports The Education Trust-West in providing technical assistance to teams from up to 16 California institutions to develop and implement plans for scaled developmental education reform pursuant to state legislative mandates.

Streamline Key Learner Transitions

Strategies to Support Holistic Credit Mobility
Ithaka Harbors, Inc. | \$1,220,400 | 03/2024 - 08/2026

This grant supports Ithaka S+R in identifying and documenting learning from postsecondary institutions that are implementing strategies to recognize and apply credits as learners move across educational settings. Ithaka S+R will facilitate peer learning and develop resources to help institutions in better supporting learner and credit mobility, thereby saving learners time and money and increasing their chances of success.

Expand Postsecondary Education in Prison

Launching the New England Prison Higher Education Collaborative
New England Board of Higher Education | \$6,762,442 | 02/2024 - 01/2029

This grant supports the New England Board of Higher Education (NEBHE) in catalyzing collaboration across and within its six New England member states to increase the quantity and quality of postsecondary education offerings in prison. As the first regional prison education collaborative, NEBHE will serve as a convener, technical assistance provider, research hub, and funder for the participating states.

Building a Multi-Sector Consensus for Expansion of Postsecondary Education in Virginia's Prisons
Virginia Interfaith Center for Public Policy | \$749,900 | 02/2024 - 01/2026

This grant supports the Virginia Interfaith Center for Public Policy (VICPP) in establishing a statewide coalition focused on increasing high-quality postsecondary education in prison in Virginia. VICCP will raise awareness about postsecondary education in prison and Pell Grant restoration for incarcerated learners and identify and recruit coalition partners.

Support Rural Postsecondary Education and Workforce Training

Building Rural Community Learning Systems: Education to Employment Partnerships
Columbus Learning Center Management Corporation | \$1,600,000 | 03/2024 - 12/2026

This grant supports CivicLab, a project of the Columbus Learning Center Management Corporation, in developing the education-to-employment partnerships in 10 rural communities. CivicLab will support rural postsecondary education and workforce training providers and employers to partner in developing and implementing plans to strengthen talent development ecosystems so that rural learners have paths to good jobs in their communities.

This grant supports the Education Writers Association in increasing the quality and volume of national postsecondary education media coverage by hosting a national seminar, developing online resources, and providing micro-fellowships to new journalists working on stories that highlight solutions to support learners from low-income backgrounds.

Rural Impact Podcast Series

This grant supports Impact! Communications, Inc. in producing seven podcast episodes, as part of their Rural Impact podcast series, focused on postsecondary education and workforce training access and success for rural adults.


